MINNESOTA COF CATHOLIC SCHOOL/CCD GRANT PROGRAM

GOAL: To assist parents, students and parishes with Catholic Grade School/CCD tuition payments.

1. The grant program was revised January 2006.
2. Local Courts must have documentation current at the High Court.
3. Local courts must have at least 15 youth members.
4. Membership list from the high court will be used to determine membership numbers.
5. Total Grant Available \$ 6,000.00 to be distributed as follows:
 - A. Youth membership increase \$50.00
 - B. The award will be based on Quarterly activities. **Courts must have activity 3 or 4 quarters to qualify.** (If you only have activity in 2 quarters you will no longer be eligible for any award).
 - C. Courts will no longer receive \$50 just for applying. **ACTIVITY MUST TAKE PLACE.**
 - D. 2011 awards will be based on 2010 activities.
6. Courts must submit their application to the State Secretary by January 31, 2011
7. Grant can only be used to supplement tuition in a Catholic Elementary School or the Parish CCD program.
8. Grant will be awarded at the April 2011 State Court Meeting under the supervision of all State Court members present.
9. The local court will have until October to determine how the grant will be presented. Award presentation to the school/CCD representative; should be made by the State Court Trustee, assigned agent, and local court officers.
10. Only one award per court per year.
